Cameroon is a Western African Country. Need You Onlus helped the Ndoumbi Centre, managed by the “Adoratrici del Santissimo Sacramento” nuns. Ndoumbi is about 350 km from the capital; the population lives thanks to subsistence farming in small areas in the rain forest and they farm: corn, manioc, peanut and planes. Families live in huts made of reeds and clay. They don’t have toilets nor windows nor electrical power. One hunt is about 30mq and even 15 people can live inside it.



The only buildings are the ones managed by the nuns. The nuns have a nursery school with 180 children, a primary school with 300 children, a professional sewing school for 50 girls. There is also an infirmary with a nurse who can carry out basic health exams.



The essential role of the nurse is to vaccinate the children up to 10 years old and the expecting mothers.

Furthermore, the nuns also support some students from the Bertoua middle school with scholastic material and contributions for the school fees: each student costs about € 700.
