Scuola Elementare Saracco e Scuola Media Bella Acqui Terme

For some years, the association has been carrying out educational projects for the Saracco - Bella primary and secondary school in Acqui Terme. It is thanks to our volunteers and teachers who enthusiastically join the initiatives and find time to help us develop projects that we can offer these activities to children and teenagers.

- Hip-hop dance courses with teacher Saimir Balla to make children discover how dance helps to be in contact with the expressive potential of the body.
- Karate courses with Laura Ferrari and Salvatore Scanu, from the Budokai Dojo gym in Acqui Terme. This discipline teaches important values such as respect for oneself and for others, it helps promote socialization and develop excellent psycho-motor skills.
- o Courses of "kindness and courtesy" with Amedeo Ripane and Don Gianpaolo Pastorini.
- Creative writing courses in collaboration with the "Book on a Tree" association. there had been meetings with children writers and creative writing workshops that aimed at developing stories to be included in an anthology: creative writing is seen as a mean of promoting the empathic intelligence of children and young people through the artistic expression.
- Theater courses with Simona Attanasio for middle school kids. Through artistic expression, role-playing games, children have the opportunity to increase their self-esteem and also to work on the importance of respecting others.
- Psycho-pedagogical workshops for children and teachers with the aim of increasing the emotional intelligence and social skills of children and giving concrete help to teachers. The workshops were developed and conducted by: Paolo Assandri and Cristina Cazzola, psychologists and by the educators and pedagogists Ilaria Landucci and Tommaso Montemurno.

Project "Pc for the schools" Acqui Terme

The Covid-19 pandemic that has hit the world has caused serious consequences for all of us. Schools found themselves having to face a new reality no one was prepared for. The only possible solution to be able to carry on the lessons was that of DAD - distance learning - through video lessons, video conferences and streaming links.

The lockdowns and restrictions necessary to contain the infections have caused important difficulties for many families who have been unable to work and without good financial support: for many the possibility of buying a tablet or PC for their children has proved impossible. Furthermore, families with several children have found themselves having to provide more electronic devices: a single tablet is divided with difficulty among family members and leads to the loss of many school lessons.

Dr. Nicola De Angelis, thanks to his daughter Vittoria who attends secondary school and who has taken this problem to heart, has proposed and contributed to this project, financing half of this initiative.

Thanks to Dr. Emanuele Cazzola, of Errepi Informatica in Acqui Terme, who offered us a special price for 37 laptops worth € 10,000, we distributed the devices to schools.
